Zur Geschichte evangelischer Ausbildungsstätten für Sozialarbeit in der Pfalz Dec 19 2021

Bald nach Ende des Zweiten Weltkrieges wurde in der Pfalz nach einer Möglichkeit gesucht, Fachkräfte für den Neuaufbau des Jugendpflege-, Fürsorge- und Wohlfahrtswesens in einer protestantischen Ausbildungsstätte zu qualifizieren. Vorbilder solcher evangelisch-sozialen Frauen- oder Wohlfahrtsschulen gab es seit Beginn des 20. Jahrhunderts auch in umliegenden Gebieten. Die Folgen des Zweiten Weltkrieges hatten es allerdings schwer gemacht, solche Ausbildungsstätten wieder oder neu zu eröffnen. Der Bedarf an Sozialarbeit und dafür gut ausgebildeten Fachkräften war angesichts der Nachkriegsnöte und sozialen Probleme jedoch groß. Die Verantwortlichen in der Pfälzischen Landeskirche gründeten im Jahr 1948 die "Evangelische Schule für kirchlichen und sozialen Dienst" in Speyer und boten dort zunächst zwei Ausbildungsgänge für Gemeindegewerkschaften und für Wohlfahrtspflegerinnen an. Damit war die erste protestantische Ausbildungsstätte für Sozialarbeit und Gemeindepädagogik in der Pfalz und für Rheinland-Pfalz eröffnet. Aus ihr ging mit der staatlichen Anerkennung im Jahr 1950 das "Seminar für Sozialberufe", ab 1964 mit dem Zusatz

"Höhere Fachschule für Sozialarbeit", hervor, das 1970 nach Ludwigshafen am Rhein in einen Neubau umzog und dort noch für ein gutes Jahr zu den "Höheren Fachschulen für Sozialarbeit und Sozialpädagogik" umfirmierte bzw. erweitert wurde, bevor diese in der zum Oktober 1971 eröffneten Fachhochschule der Pfälzischen Landeskirche aufgingen. Die vorliegende Untersuchung möchte gleichermaßen einen Beitrag zur Professions-, Disziplin- und Institutionengeschichte der Sozialen Arbeit und kirchlich-diakonischer Berufe wie zur Zeitgeschichte der evangelischen Kirche mit ihrer Diakonie leisten. Sie widmet sich den evangelischen Ausbildungsstätten in der Pfalz im sekundären Bildungsbereich in den Jahren 1948 bis 1971 mit der entsprechenden Vorgeschichte seit 1945. Angefügt ist zudem ein Überblick über die Entwicklungen der sich anschließenden Bildungseinrichtung des tertiären Bereiches, der Evangelischen Fachhochschule in Ludwigshafen, von 1971 bis 2008. Die hier erforschten Entwicklungen zeichnen exemplarisch den Prozess der Professionalisierung des Berufes und den Weg der disziplinären Akademisierung der Sozialen Arbeit und z.T. auch der Gemeinde- bzw. Religionspädagogik nach.

The Jews in Genoa Jul 14 2021 These volumes of the "Documentary History of the Jews in Italy," illustrate the history of the Jews in Genoa and surroundings from Antiquity to the French Revolution. The earliest documentary evidence takes the form of letters from King Theodoric. For the Middle Ages the documentation is relatively fragmentary and sporadic. Later there is greater abundance of historical evidence, which portrays chiefly the destinies of the Jews in the Republic from the sixteenth century on, when the presence of the Jews became permanent and a regular community was established also in the capital. The historical records presented illustrate mainly the relationship between the government of the Genoese Republic and the Jews, the latter's economic activities and their communal and social life. Some of the detailed descriptions of the Jewish population in Genoa, their living conditions and occupations, allow for a close examination of the social conditions of this Northern Italian community. For a while Genoa became a haven of refuge for some of the exiles from Spain, including the historian Joseph Hacoen and members of the Abarbanel family. The volumes are provided with an extensive introduction, bibliography, glossary and indexes.

Who Runs the Economy? Oct 25 2019 Since the financial crisis of 2008 and the following Great Recession, there has been surprisingly little change in the systems of ideas, institutions and policies which preceded the crash and helped bring it about. 'Mainstream' economics carries on much as it did before. Despite much discussion of what went wrong, very little has substantially changed. Perhaps the answer has something to do with power; a subject on which economics is unusually quiet. Whilst economics may be able to discuss bargaining power and market power, it fails to explore the reciprocal connections between economic ideas and politics: the political power of economic ideas on the one side, and the influence of power structures on economic thought on the other. This book explores how the supposedly neutral discipline of economics does not simply describe human behaviour, but in fact shapes it.

Economics After the Crisis Nov 18 2021 A noted economist challenges the fundamental economic assumptions that cast economic growth as the objective and markets as the universally applicable means of achieving it. The global economic crisis of 2008–2009 seemed a crisis not just of economic performance but also of the system's underlying political ideology and economic theory. But a second Great Depression was averted, and the radical shift to New Deal-like economic policies predicted by some never took place. Perhaps the correct response to the crisis is simply careful management of the macroeconomic challenges as we recover, combined with reform of financial regulation to prevent a recurrence. In this text we address the topic of loss models, traditionally called risk theory by actuaries, including the estimation of such models from sample data. The theory of survival models is addressed in other texts, including the ACTEX work entitled Models for Quantifying Risk which might be considered a companion text to this one. In Risk Models and Their Estimation we consider as well the estimation of survival models, in both tabular and parametric form, from sample data. This text is a valuable reference for those preparing for Exam C of the Society of Actuaries and Exam 4 of the Casualty Actuarial Society. A separate solutions' manual with detailed solutions to the text exercises is also available.
