Beneficial Ownership Mar 01 2020 The hunt for beneficial owners is on. Corporate Governance, Ownership Structure and Firm Performance Feb 09 2021 The relationship between ownership structure and firm performance has been studied extensively in corporate finance and corporate governance literature. Nevertheless, the mediation (path) analysis to examine the issue can be adopted as a new approach to explain why and how ownership structure is related to firm performance and vice versa.
